INDICATION

ARISTADA INITIO® (aripiprazole lauroxil) is a prescription medicine given as a **one-time injection** and is used in combination with oral aripiprazole to start ARISTADA® (aripiprazole lauroxil) treatment, or re-start ARISTADA treatment after a missed dose, when ARISTADA is used for the treatment of schizophrenia in adults.

ARISTADA is a prescription medicine given by injection by a healthcare professional and used to treat schizophrenia in adults.

It is not known if ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA are safe and effective in children under 18 years of age.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION FOR ARISTADA INITIO AND ARISTADA

Elderly people with dementia-related psychosis are at increased risk of death when treated with antipsychotic medicines including ARISTADA INITIO and ARISTADA. ARISTADA INITIO and ARISTADA are not for the treatment of people who have lost touch with reality (psychosis) due to confusion and memory loss (dementia).

KNOW SOME SIGNS of Schizophrenia

Certain behaviors could be signs that someone may have schizophrenia. These include:

- Social withdrawal
- Hostility or suspiciousness
- Lack of expression
- Decline in personal hygiene
- Trouble focusing or paying attention

These are not all of the signs of schizophrenia

It's important to talk to a healthcare provider if you are worried that someone you love may have schizophrenia.



Is a LONG-ACTING TREATMENT right for your loved one?

The most common medicines for schizophrenia can be taken by mouth or by injection. Both of these options provide the treatment needed. The difference is how they're taken.



Long-acting injectables

are given by a healthcare provider and can offer different durations of treatment, depending on the medication chosen.



OPAL MEDICATIONS.

such as pills, are taken by mouth every day.

Help the person you care for explore their treatment options

There are multiple options for treating schizophrenia. It can be helpful to find out what treatment options are available. Then, you and/or your loved one can have an informed discussion with their healthcare provider about which treatment approach may be right for them.

Contraindication: Do not receive ARISTADA INITIO or ARISTADA if you are allergic to aripiprazole or any of the ingredients in ARISTADA. Allergic reactions to aripiprazole have ranged from rash, hives and itching to anaphylaxis, which may include difficulty breathing, tightness in the chest, and swelling of the mouth, face, lips, or tongue.

ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA may cause serious side effects including:

 Cerebrovascular problems (including stroke) in elderly people with dementia-related psychosis that can lead to death.

1 dose can provide treatment for 2 Months

ARISTADA® is a long-acting injectable medication that can provide 2 months (1064 mg) of treatment. When receiving ARISTADA, your loved one will have one less medicine to remember to take every day.


After establishing tolerability to oral aripiprazole, treatment with ARISTADA can start in one of two ways:

They will receive one injection of ARISTADA INITIO® (aripiprazole lauroxil) and one 30 mg dose of oral aripiprazole on the same day. The first injection of ARISTADA will be given on that same day or within the following 10 days.

On the first day, they will receive an injection of ARISTADA and then take oral aripiprazole daily for 21 days if ARISTADA INITIO is not right for them.

- OR -

It's important that they not miss a dose of ARISTADA. If a dose is missed, they should contact their healthcare provider to discuss what to do next.



See if a 2-Month dosing option may be right for your loved one

How often they are treated with ARISTADA (aripiprazole lauroxil) depends on the dosage of medication that they and their healthcare provider decide is right for them.

Other dosing options include:

Every 2 months	Every 6 weeks	Every 1 month
1064 mg	882 mg	441 mg 662 mg 882 mg

ARISTADA is slowly released into the body to last for weeks at a time with 1 injection.

ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA may cause serious side effects including: (continued)

- Neuroleptic malignant syndrome (NMS), a serious condition that can lead to death. Call your healthcare provider or go to the nearest hospital emergency room right away if you have some or all of the following signs and symptoms of NMS:
 - high fever
- sweating
- stiff muscles
- changes in pulse, heart
- confusion
- rate, and blood pressure
- Uncontrolled body movements (tardive dyskinesia).
 ARISTADA INITIO and ARISTADA may cause
 movements that you cannot control in your face,
 tongue, or other body parts. Tardive dyskinesia may
 not go away, even if you stop receiving ARISTADA.
 Tardive dyskinesia may also start after you stop
 receiving ARISTADA.

WHAT TO KNOW

before your loved one starts treatment

- Before starting treatment with ARISTADA INITIO® (aripiprazole lauroxil) or ARISTADA® (aripiprazole lauroxil), tell their healthcare provider if they have not taken Abilify®, Abilify Maintena®, or any aripiprazole product before
 - This is because people who are allergic to aripiprazole or any of the ingredients in ARISTADA should not receive ARISTADA or ARISTADA INITIO
- If they've never taken aripiprazole before, their healthcare provider may have them take oral aripiprazole for a short time to see if they can tolerate it before they start treatment

It's also important to tell the healthcare provider about all their medical conditions, including if they:

- Have or had heart problems or stroke
- Have diabetes or high blood sugar or a family history of diabetes or high blood sugar. The healthcare provider should check on their blood sugar before they receive ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA and during their treatment
- Have or had low or high blood pressure
- Have or had seizures (convulsions)
- Have or had a low white blood cell count.
- Have problems that may affect them receiving an injection in their buttocks or their arm
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant. It is not known if ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA will harm their unborn baby. If they become pregnant while on treatment, talk to the healthcare provider about registering with the National Pregnancy Registry for Atypical Antipsychotics. They can register by calling 1-866-961-2388, or visit womensmentalhealth.org/ research/pregnancyregistry/
- Are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed. ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA can pass into their breast milk.
 It is not known if it may harm their baby. Talk to the healthcare provider about the best way to feed their baby if they receive ARISTADA INITIO and/or ARISTADA.

Every person responds to schizophrenia medication differently. In clinical studies, ARISTADA® (aripiprazole lauroxil) was shown to reduce symptoms of schizophrenia.

Some common symptoms:

- Hallucinations
 - ons
- Delusions
- Unusual thinking or disorganized speech
- Loss of motivation
- Disinterest or lack of enjoyment in daily activities
- Difficulty showing emotions
- Difficulty processing information to make decisions

These are not all of the symptoms of schizophrenia.

GETTING STARTED can happen in just one day

After discussing with their healthcare provider and establishing tolerability to oral aripiprazole, there are 3 steps to beginning their treatment:

The healthcare provider will give them a one-time injection of ARISTADA INITIO® (aripiprazole lauroxil) and a single 30 mg dose of oral aripiprazole.

Alternatively, their healthcare provider could give them oral aripiprazole for 21 days in a row when they receive their first injection of ARISTADA® (aripiprazole lauroxil).

- 2. They will receive their first dose of ARISTADA either on the same day as ARISTADA INITIO or up to 10 days later.
- After receiving their initial doses, their following injections of ARISTADA (1064 mg) will be every 2 months, unless they and the healthcare provider have decided on a different dosing option.

How ARISTADA is given:

- Both ARISTADA INITIO and ARISTADA are given by injection by a healthcare provider into the muscle (intramuscular)
- Depending on the dose, ARISTADA can be given in the upper arm (441 mg only) or buttock (all doses). ARISTADA INITIO can be given in either the upper arm or buttock
- Follow the ARISTADA treatment schedule exactly as the healthcare provider says to
- There are multiple dosing options for ARISTADA. Talk to the healthcare provider to see what's right for them

Talking to your loved one

Here are some things to consider discussing with them:

- Encourage them to feel that they can speak up and advocate for themselves
- Validate their worries and fears
 - Validating sounds like: "That must be [scary, stressful, etc]. Would it be helpful if...?"
- Make sure you know and understand the side effects of their treatment
- Make sure you and/or your loved one is/are prepared to discuss treatment options with their healthcare provider

Focus on the day and the joy you can find in it. The little things that go right can add up to a positive experience. If you keep a journal, make sure to write down 1 good thing each day.



Live HEALTHY

Make sure you are taking care of yourself and seeing your healthcare provider for your annual checkups.



Be MINDFUL of your feelings

Being a caregiver can be overwhelming. It's important to notice these feelings without passing judgment and then refocus on the job at hand.



REACH out for support
